



JUMPSTART YOUR DEGREE WITH SUMMER COURSES

TENTATIVE DATES: June 20 – August 15

Courses take place during evening hours

BIOLOGY I: MOLECULAR AND CELL (with Lab)

- Fulfills Science requirement.
- Prerequisite for all advanced science courses, including Anatomy & Physiology I, which is offered in the fall.
- All students planning to go into health/medical fields (e.g., OT, PT, nursing, PA, sonography) must take this course before starting the fall semester. Students will not be able to register for fall semester advanced science courses without biology with a lab.

COMPUTER CONCEPTS & APPLICATIONS

- Fulfills Technology requirement.
- Required for specialized certificate programs (e.g., sonography, OTA, business.)

ENGLISH COMPOSITION I

- Fulfills English requirement. All students are required to have this course, unless a score of 4 or 5 has been earned on AP English.
- Requirement for many graduate and professional programs, including OT, business.

FOOD AND CULTURE

- Fulfills Diversity or Social Science requirement.

FUNDAMENTALS OF COMMUNICATION (Public Speaking)

- Fulfills English II requirement.
- Requirement for many majors and graduate programs, including business, psychology and sonography.

INTRODUCTION TO ADOBE CREATIVE SUITE

- For graphic design students.
- Fulfills Technology requirements.

INTRODUCTION TO STATISTICS

- Fulfills Math requirement.
- Requirement for many fields, including business, health/medical and psychology.
