Notes:

- Fall cohort includes degree-seeking and certificate-seeking students who started at WITS that fall or the previous spring semester.
- Beginning with the Fall 2020 Cohort, WITS offered a freshman Israel Study Abroad Program plus 2 new Certificate programs which accounts for the steep increase in enrollment. The previous cohorts were comprised of 95% transfer students, entering at the sophomore or junior levels. Many of those students graduated during their following fall semester as WITS used to offer rolling graduation dates. Therefore, the continuing second year fall enrollment for Fall 2017, 2018 and 2019 Cohorts includes students who returned or graduated by October of the next fall. WITS now has 3 set graduation dates, following the fall, spring and summer semesters. Starting with the Fall 2020 Cohort, the criteria for continuing second year fall enrollment only includes students who returned to WITS.
- Pell eligibility began with Fall 2018 cohort.
