MAT 232 Calculus II	Prerequisite: MAT 231. Required for computer science major
PSY 397 Group Dynamics	Prerequisite: PSY 101 or SOC 101. Fulfills diversity, social science or psychology elective
BIB 373 Megillas Eichla (Lamentations)	Prerequisite: Completion of 12 credits of Jewish studies or permission of the Executive Dean/Menahel
BIB 325, PSY 225 Living Tehillim in Challenging Times	Prerequisite: Completion of 12 credits of Jewish studies or permission of the Executive Dean/Menahel
